COURSE GOALS: This three day course focuses on basic radiological detection, survey instruments, risk-based response, personal protective equipment (PPE), and radiological incidents. The course consists of both classroom instruction and scenario-driven, hands-on, performance-oriented practical exercises with actual radiological sources.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND: The target audience for this course includes the following: Law Enforcement, Fire Service, Hazardous Material teams

PREREQUISITES REQUIRED: FEMA Independent Study Courses; IS-700 NIMS; and IS-100a, Introduction to Incident Command System.
